**Comments on Teaching Experience at University Level**

***Undergraduate:***

- a) The preparatory/Introductory course includes elementary Ontology, Epistemology, Logics, Ethics and Literature. These involved liaison with colleagues at the Departments of philosophy and English.
- b) The second part included Introductory Philosophy of Science; Philosophy, Language, and terms of Anatomy as a science.
- c) These I organized, coordinated, and led as the Acting Head of Department.
- d) Under Gross Anatomy, I took **Head and Neck** lectures (shared these with Dr. O. Bolarinwa for two years), and participated in demonstrations, tutorials, viva-voce and all in course amendments.
- e) Under Neuroanatomy, I prepared and took the lectures, practical sessions and other aspects as above.
- f) My Neurosurgery teachings involve lectures, tutorials, clinics, bedside, Accident and Emergency and Operating theatre sessions in addition to tests and examinations.

## ***Postgraduate lectures***

### ***Gross and Neuroanatomy:***

I prepare and take the entire Advanced Gross anatomy including Osteology and dissections; the same applies to Advanced Neuroanatomy. The techniques of these include formal lectures, tutorials, seminars, course works, demonstrations and viva-voce.

My project supervision involves guidance in Topic selection, literature review, formulation of question, goals and objectives; selection and modification of technique, data gathering, sorting, interpretation and discussions. I also guide seminar and project work presentations.

## **Professional**

Postgraduate professional training of Neurosurgeons which I have shared with my trainer is a rigorous and intimate formal apprenticeship which involves related basic Neurosciences and applied disciplines. We organize rotations through Neurology and Neuropathology and have academic sessions with experts in related fields.

Sessions include formal and informal teaching sessions, tutorials, journal reviews; clinico-pathological sessions, ward and Grand Rounds, and staged training in operating skills. The emphasis in all these is a critical grasp of the underlying logics of concepts, choices, and activities.

May I also make a note on my being the Internal-External Examiner at our Department of English. I was asked to review, evaluate and examine the Ph.D. thesis and candidate, I opine, probably because the topic was "Literature in Medicine" and probably because of my activities in similar fields.


